## Lipodissolve firm files for bankruptcy

ST. LOUIS (AP) - A suburban St. Louis company that provided fat-dissolving injections has sought bankruptcy protection.

The Chapter Eleven reorganization filing comes one month after Go Fig closed 17 clinics and left about 500 people out of work.

Go Fig, which does business as Fig, had sites in the Dallas and Houston areas.

The only 1 of its 18 clinics to remain open was in Costa Mesa, California, which is independently owned.

The company provided Lipodissolve treatments. Officials say it's a process in which injections of a compound substance melts fat and flushes it from the body.

Fig last month posted a message on its Web site saying that "due to economic conditions beyond our control."

The company ceased operations December 7th.
